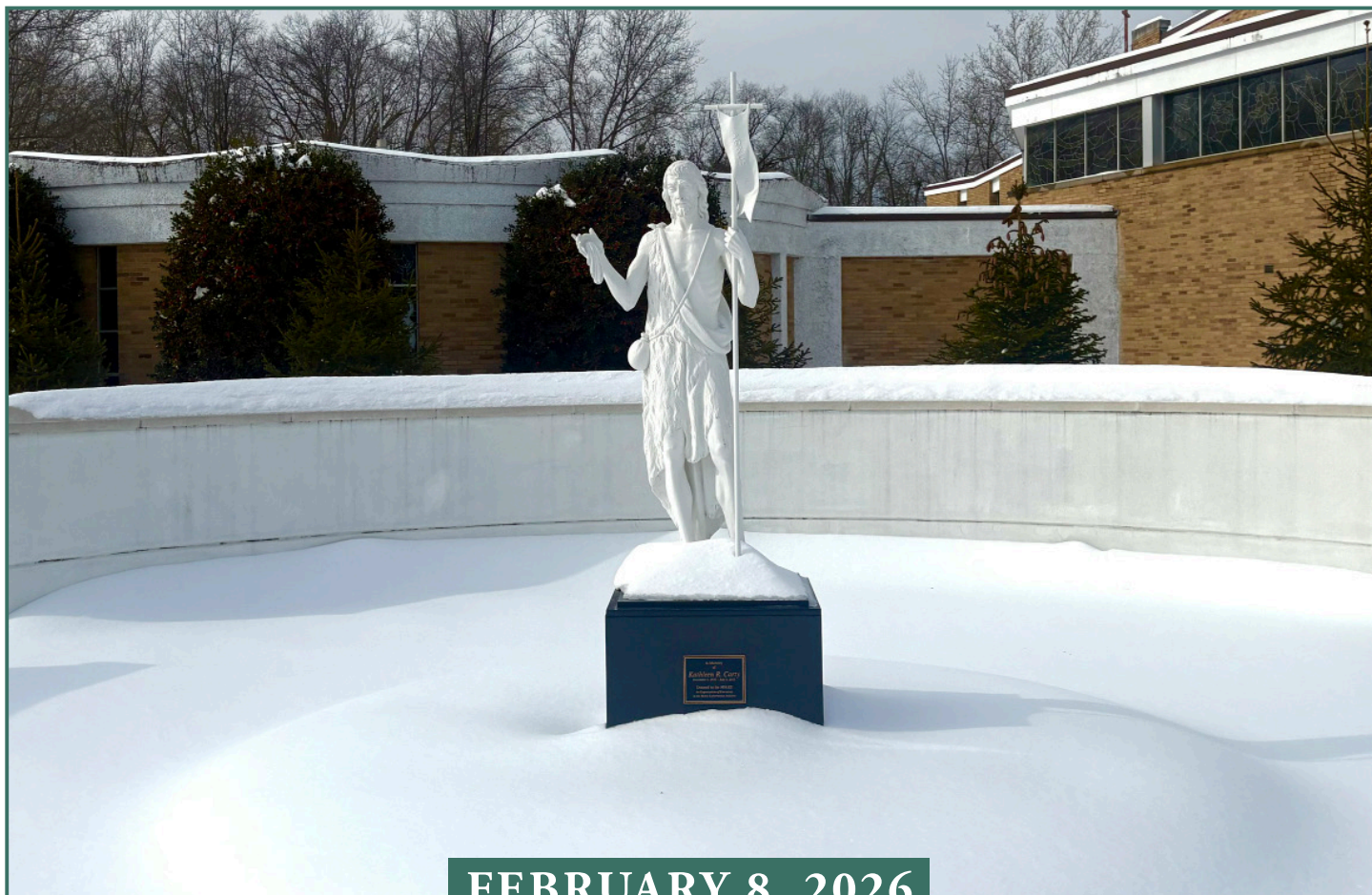

Dear Brothers and Sisters of the Saint John the Baptist Parish Family,
Dear Friends of our Parish,

Thank you for joining our family of faith in celebration of this Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, as we will hear in the Gospel a beautiful, but so very challenging, personal note of our Savior: (Yes, I call it a personal note because if Jesus would be writing and mailing us personal notes, this would certainly be one of them.)

"You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket; it is set on a lampstand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father." (Matthew 5:13-16)

These powerful words certainly give us an opportunity to reflect on so many ways in which we are being called either as individuals or as a community of the Lord's disciples "to be that light" in the lives of others through our love, care, kindness, generosity and the daily witness of our faith. Somewhere between those two "*being the light of the world*" lies the true meaning, purpose, and challenge of our annual charitable fundraising effort on behalf of our brothers and sisters in need in our Archdiocese. Among them are children, young people, and elderly; those who have had a great life blessing to be born and grow up in our beautiful country, but also those immigrants who need urgent assistance through Catholic Charities. Among those who will benefit from our personal sacrificial gifts are countless lay people, but also our Archdiocesan seminarians, religious women and men, deacons, and priests. The Appeal provides an opportunity for a caring community like St. John's to support a broad variety of charitable efforts of our local Catholic Church. It funds essential programs and ministries at the heart of our Catholic mission - namely to proclaim the Gospel, to pass on the faith to future generations, particularly through the celebration of the sacraments, and to care for the poor and those on the margins. In order to assure that our sacrificial gift will get exactly "where you want it to go," we are free to restrict our contributions on the back side of the Annual Appeal donation envelopes (which can be found by the doors of the church) and "direct them" to our most favorite charitable causes, while always noting that we are members of St. John the Baptist Parish in Hillsdale.

Please, know that I am very grateful for your support and all your kindness, witness of your faith, and the goodness of your hearts. Please, let's all together "shine the light" of this wonderful community of faith to the entire Archdiocese of Newark.
